

The new 28 foot twin-engine fiberglass | Hatteras



This view of the cockpit shows its roominess with space for a fighting chair and two fishing chairs; as well as the engine boxes which can serve as seats or tables. Likewise, its shows how accessible the engines are for ser-vicing. Note the low con-tour of the cockpit that also facilitates boarding fish.



The Hatteras-designed control console has a leather-grain Parkwood panel with Morse Controls, complete dual instruments and switches, including fuel gauge. The 4 in. "Corsair" or the 5 in. "Constellation" compass is optional.



The head has 6 ft. 2 in. headroom. Light fixtures, storage lockers galore (5½ cu. ft. of space). Contourmolded countertop and sink. Pressure water system. Large mirror. Medicine cabinet. Two 110-volt outlets. Vinyl floor. (All standard.)

because of its one-piece fiberglass hull and fiberglass super-structure. No seams, no joints, no loose fastenings. Rust, dry rot, caulking and sanding are eliminated. Paint for appearance, if you want to, but you don't have to paint for protection.

With its 12 ft. 5 in. beam, the interior of the Hatteras 28 footer is larger and has more usable space than any other boat in the same range. Headroom here is 6 ft. 2 in. Windshield and screened side windows of trunk cabin provide 22½ square feet of window space for exceptional light and viewing.



Dividing the living area from the bow stateroom are two hanging lockers, each with 9¾ cu. ft. of space. The bow stateroom has two 6 ft. 3½ in. berths with polyfoam mattresses. There are 6 drawers beneath the berths with 5½ cu. ft. of storage space. The rope locker has 13½ cu. ft. of space. Two 110-volt outlets.

The efficient design has the dinette a step away from the galley—very convenient.

The dinette seats four, converts to a double bed to sleep two. Curtains are standard. There's a full hanging locker aft of the dinette, as well as drawers underneath the seats. Storage cabinet in sidewall. 110-volt duplex outlet; and 12-volt light fixtures are standard.

Efficient, roomy galley. Large enough to work, with walk-by room. A 3 cu. ft. locker. Stainless steel sink with pressure water system. 4 cu. ft. ice box and 2-burner alcohol stove are standard. Headroom 6 ft. 2 in. 110-volt outlets for appliances. Optionally available are hot water, electric refrigerator, and electric stove.



This Hatteras 28 will move along — (over 40 m.p.h. with 290 HP engines, under normal conditions). It is unusually easy to handle and maneuver. Fiberglass reinforced plastic is the strongest material for marine construction. It permits a more efficient hull shape. It virtually eliminates pounding, yawing and broaching. Even at high speeds, it throws water off in a low flat arc. Note that a skilled water skier


Note that a skilled water skier can enjoy riding behind this 28 footer when run at average speed. Expert skiers could have a ball with 28 footer opened up some.
