There are many boats that are beautiful. And many that are beasts. A few provide some combination of both.

Only Hatteras pours in the generous measures of beauty and brawn that you'll find in the 36 Convertible. And no wonder. It's an original recipe dating back more than 20 years.

And every year since, the recipe and its ingre-

dients have gotten better and better.

Consider the brawn portion of our 36. The hull is incredibly strong. Like every Hatteras hull, the 36's is one-piece molded fiberglass. Above the waterline, the fiberglass is cored for added stiffness. Below the waterline, it's solid fiberglass.

Additional strength and stiffness is provided by means of a stringer system unique to Hatteras. Made of fiberglass and aluminum, it runs athwartships as well as fore and aft in a waffle-like pattern.

Complementing the strength of the 36's hull is its design—constant deadrise, modified-vee


with an exceptionally deep forefoot.


So the 36 gets on plane quickly, is stable in open water and knifes through head seas.

That adds up to a hull in which you have greater confidence while running, trolling or at the dock, and in which you have greater interior space as well.

To send the 36 skimming, 3 power combinations are available: two choices of diesels, one of gasoline engines.

The flying bridge is roomy. Its control station today's normal complement of electronics. Forward is lounge seating for guests plus excellent storage.





Our 20 years of refining the recipe for Hatteras sport fishing convertibles also works wonders in the cockpit area. For one thing, it's wide. Especially for a 36 footer. And that feature is followed by a long list of Hatteras "musts."

The all-fiberglass cockpit includes: self-bailing transom gate, non-skid deck, lazarette storage, engine air intakes under cockpit coaming to help provide dry air, sliding door to the salon, teak and stainless steel ladder to the flying bridge.

Also available for the cockpit area: removable lazarette fish well, top-loading bait freezer, bait and tackle center and cockpit control

station.













STANDARD LOWER GALLEY ARRANGEMENT features full-sized salon, lower level galley, bow stateroom.

Looking aft in salon/upper galley arrangement. Glass-paneled door slides open and out of the way.


# **Bottom Center:**

On the 36 Convertible, those items include: Hatteras master electrical panels for easy comprehension and handling of 120V AC and 12V DC electrical systems, automatic battery charger, CO² fire extinguishing system, Hatteras Systems Monitor with audible and visual warning for drive oil temperature (diesel power only), engine water temperature and oil pressure, exhaust temperature and discharge of the automatic engine room fire extinguishing system.
