

# The 38 foot fiberglass **Hatteras** Double Cabin







## This 38-foot fiberglass **Hatteras** than you'll find

This 38-foot Double Cabin Hatteras not only gives you more boat than many 40 footers—its luxurious accommodations approach those of many 44's.

In addition to the spacious aft and forward staterooms, there is a third, smaller stateroom especially suitable for children.

And—to please the boatwife who wants to be with her guests, particularly at the most sociable hour of the day, the galley has been incorporated into the deckhouse salon.

Three double portlights (there are

six portlights in all) provide more light and ventilation for the aft master stateroom.

A comfortable cushioned bow seat with deck storage underneath is standard equipment.

The hard top is longer than usual and provides more complete coverage of the after deck.

### **Extras as standard equipment**

*The master stateroom* has twin berths; wall-to-wall carpeting; 110-volt and 12-volt lights and outlets; full-length mirror; two hanging lockers; chest of

drawers; shelves; private head.

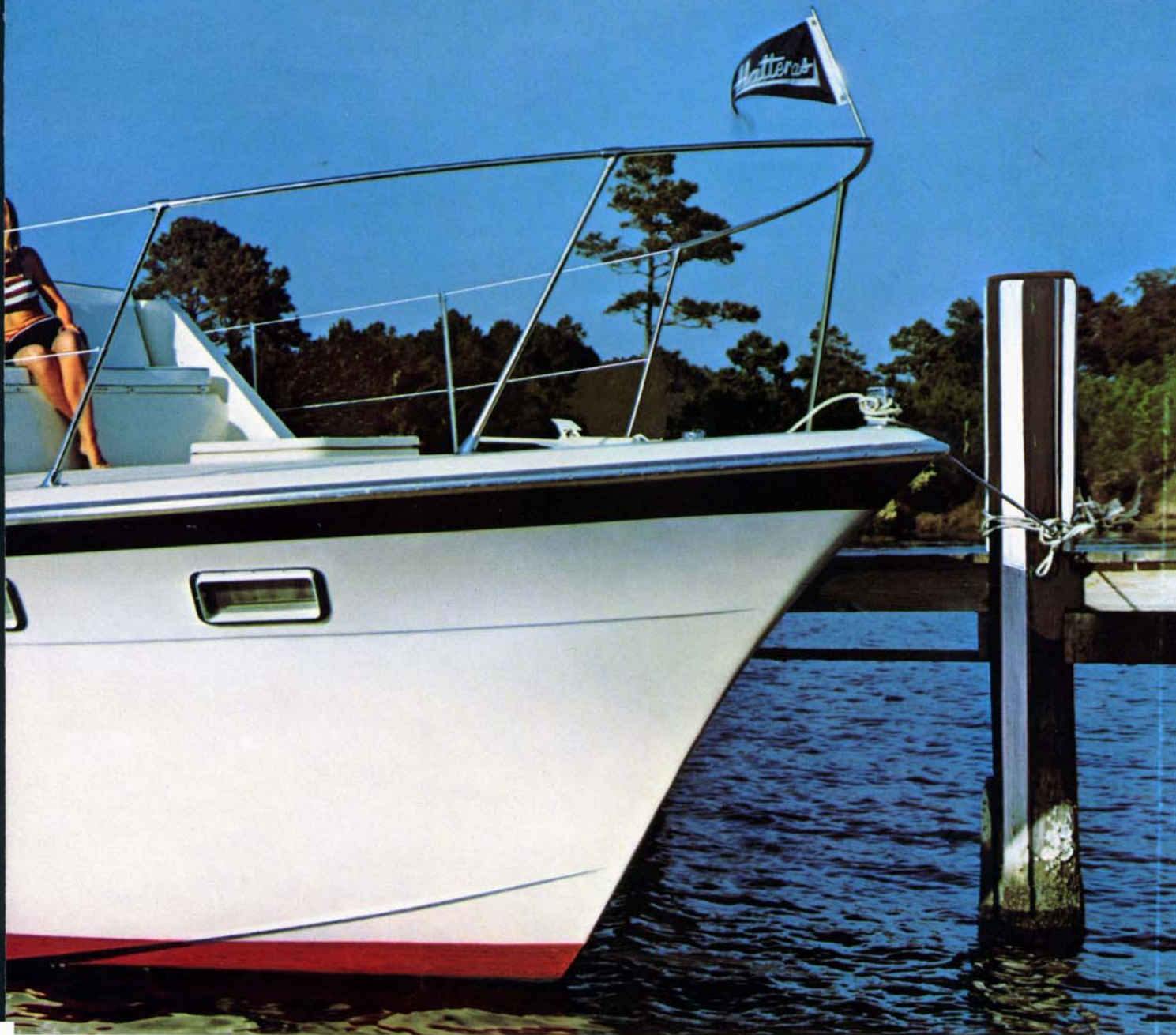
*The spacious deckhouse salon* includes wall-to-wall carpeting; stereo tape player; 110-volt and 12-volt lights and outlets.

*In the galley* are a 2-burner electric stove; sink with hot and cold water; electric refrigerator.

Each of the two heads are equipped with a hot and cold water shower; electric toilet; medicine cabinet with mirror; lavatory; linen storage; and portlight.

The master head has a stall shower with sump pump and curtain, and a

vitreous china lavatory.

Control station standard equipment includes compass with light; two electric windshield wipers; battery selector switch.

This Hatteras sleeps 6 and can sleep 8 with the optional convertible sofa bed.

### **More room—less maintenance**

You'll like the roominess of this yacht. There's more usable interior space than you'll find in comparable wood boats because of the molded fiberglass construction. Beams, ribs, and frames are eliminated.

The same fiberglass construction also makes the Hatteras 38 much easier to maintain than boats of other materials.

With its one-piece molded fiberglass hull, there are no underwater seams or joints to caulk or sand. Hatteras fiberglass is impervious to marine borers or worms.

You can repaint for looks if you want to, but you never need to paint for protection.

### **A safe seaworthy boat**

The Hatteras handles easily, and is exceptionally seaworthy.

Use of fiberglass makes possible a hull shape that virtually eliminates pounding, yawing and broaching.

It is a dry boat. The molded flare of hull throws water off in a low, flat arc, even at high speeds.

The reinforced Hatteras molded hull and the strong resilient quality of fiberglass take the shock of heavy seas and the effects of collision better than boats built of other materials.

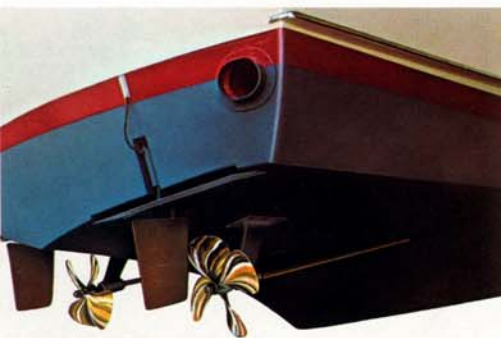
### **Power options**

Powered by twin gasoline or diesel engines.





This close-up view of the control station on the bridge shows the standard equipment: Battery selector switch, single lever controls, compass. Chart deck is 6 ft. 9 in. x 8 ft. 4 in. with hatch to deckhouse companionway. There is a ventilating windshield; a hardtop with a dome light. Height on aft deck to hardtop is 6 ft. 5 in.



Special feature of this 38 is the deep keel for better protection of running gear. It is an aid to a more stabilized ride, as are the standard adjustable tabs as shown.



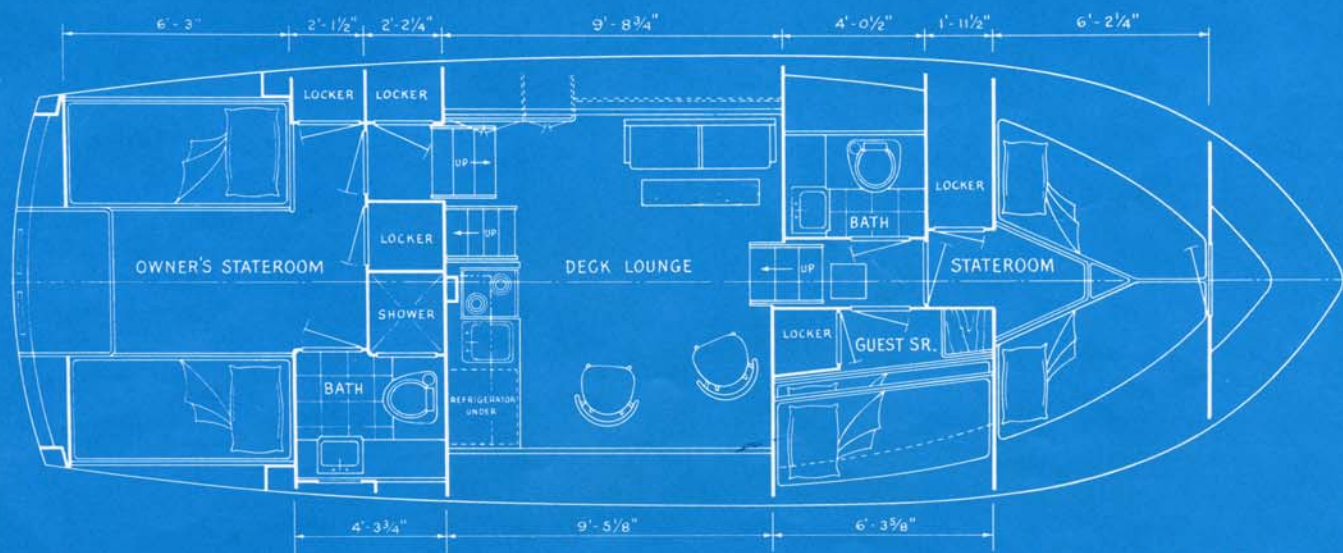
The Master's aft stateroom has two fore-and-aft bunks—each 6 ft. 3 in. with comfortable foam mattresses. Wall-to-wall carpeting. Headroom is 6 ft. 2 in.

There is 43 cu. ft. of storage space in hanging locker, recessed space in stern above each bunk, and in the 8-drawer built-in dresser (top is 30 in. x 49 in.). There are three pairs of screened portlights, 2 each port, starboard and

stern. An 8 in. x 64 in. shelf extends beneath both port and starboard portlights.

A full length mirror, air conditioning optional, two duplex 110-v. outlets for accessories. Overhead screened hatch.

Access to steering controls and bilge is a hatch at base of dresser. A private entrance to the head.

Guest stateroom has upper and lower 6 ft. 3 in. bunks with foam mattresses. 12-volt lights over each bunk. Built-in chest, hanging locker and drawer beneath lower bunk provide 17 cu. ft. storage. Mirror over chest. Floor is carpeted. Headroom is 6 ft. 3 in. Screened portlight.



Aft head has stall shower with curtain. Vitreous china lavatory in a 17 in. x 50 in. vanity. Medicine cabinet. Screened portlight. Vinyl floor covering. Electric toilet. Duplex 110-volt outlet. 9 cu. ft. storage for linens and supplies. 12-volt light.



Bow stateroom has 2 Vee bunks each 6 ft. 3 in. with foam mattresses. Two screened portlights and an overhead screened hatch. Headroom is 6 ft. 3 in. Hanging locker and drawers beneath bunk and in V-cabinet provide 17 cu. ft. of storage space, plus additional space in rope locker. Vinyl floor and wall covering. Duplex 110-volt outlets. 12-volt lights.



Bow head has vanity with stainless steel lavatory. 12-volt light. 110-volt Duplex outlet for accessories. Electric toilet. Medicine cabinet with mirror. Shower with curtain. There is 9½ cu. ft. of storage space in vanity base, one drawer and outboard locker. Screened portlight.





The Hi-Lo table shown in coffee table position is fine for a couple, but it can be raised and opened to make a table for four or more persons.

Galley has two-burner electric stove with oven, an exhaust fan, fluorescent lamp. Stainless steel sink. Hot and cold running water. Overhead cabinets and drawers beneath sink provide 6 cu. ft. of storage space. Center cabinet is damp-proofed to keep salt, sugar, crackers, etc. fresh. Duplex 110-volt outlet for appliances.







Deckhouse salon with galley is an efficiency apartment with more roominess than you would imagine. Beam width window-to-window is 9 ft. 8 in., 12 ft. 3 in. from aft bulkhead to forward bulkhead and headroom is 6 ft. 3 in. Sliding windows are screened. Optionals for seating and sleeping

include a sofa bed, Hi-Lo table, Rattan chair. There is 4 cu. ft. of storage space in starboard bulkhead behind sliding doors. Forward are two large shelves: 26 in. x 43 in. on port side, 49 in. x 29½ in. on starboard side. Duplex 110-volt outlets for accessories.



Optional air conditioning has reverse cycle for cooling or heating.



Optional ice maker is an entertainment asset. The stereo player is standard.

Hatteras Master Electric Panel, the last word in yacht safety and electronics. Central control and protection for both 12-volt and 110-volt. All circuits have circuit breakers and master switches. Switches for generator and battery charger circuit. Indicator for Battery condition.
