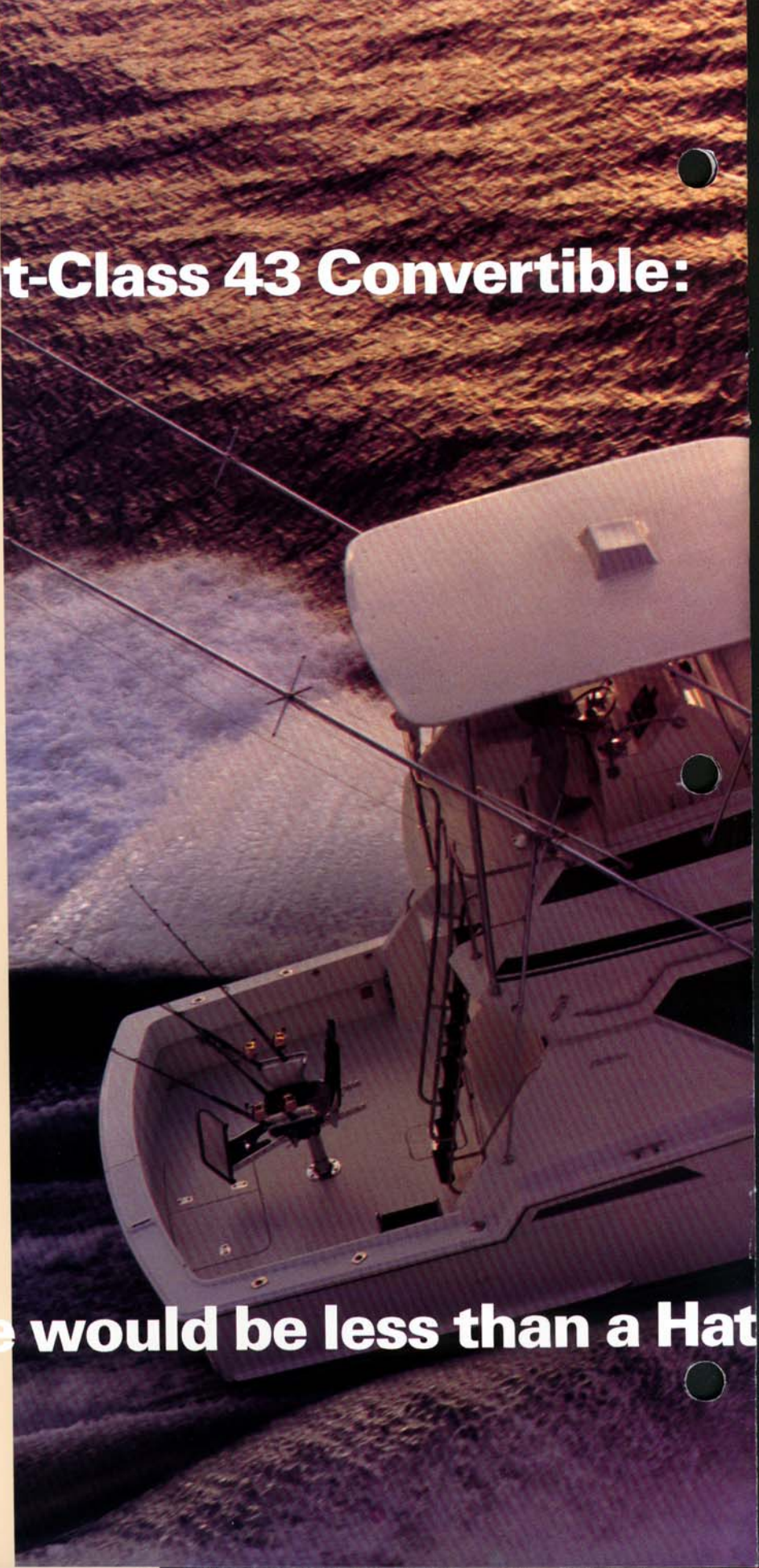

From the flybridge down, the fresh ideas are everywhere. A specially formed wraparound windshield deflects the wind without encumbering the styling. Comfortable seating, with storage below, both port side and forward. The helm is *designed* for visibility, with a new console that accommodates today's elaborate electronic packages.

The cockpit will give any fish nightmares. It's 120 square feet! A tournament-class transom door with lift-up coaming gate is standard. So is the removable fishbox, flush in the deck. So is the molded-in bait and tackle center that features a sink and faucet, storage tub, and tackle drawers. So is the fresh-water washdown!

The living space is a decorator's dream. Standard furnishings include an L-shaped lounge and an attractive hi-lo table. An icemaker is tucked into the starboard bulkhead; a serving counter built out from the port side opens to the galley.

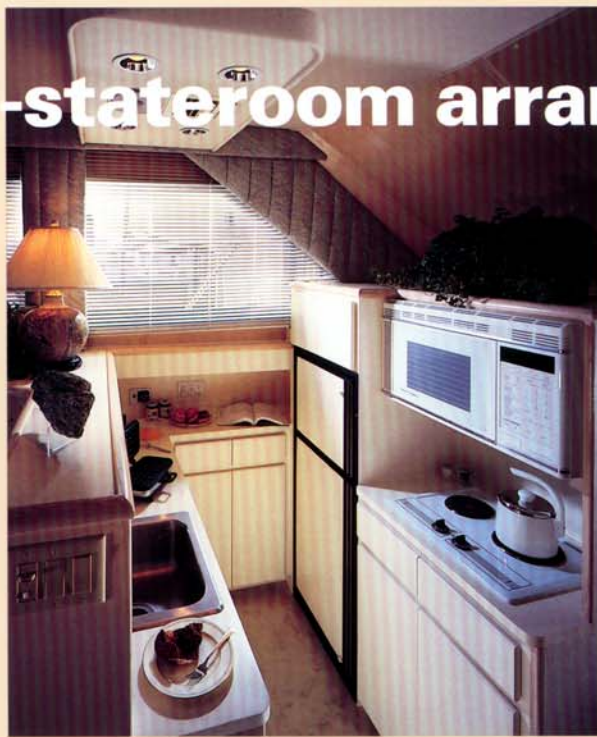
The beautifully-finished entertainment center is topped off by a 20" color TV and AM/FM stereo cassette player.

Two steps down is proof that serving supper can be as rewarding as landing it. Fully equipped, the galley is open to the salon to keep the cook in touch with the guests. Shoulder-high windows add to the open, beautifully lit workspace.

There's a dinette option as well, that visually extends the already large floorspace even more, and converts to a double bunk.

The Hatteras 43C also includes, as standard, a 32,000 BTU air conditioning system.



Can you imagine a galley that actually entices you to cook? This beautifully designed galley features AC/DC refrigerator with freezer; two-burner cooktop and microwave/convection oven; high-pressure laminate countertops and storage cabinets; a stainless steel sink; and even a pantry forward, sized for a washer/dryer at your option.

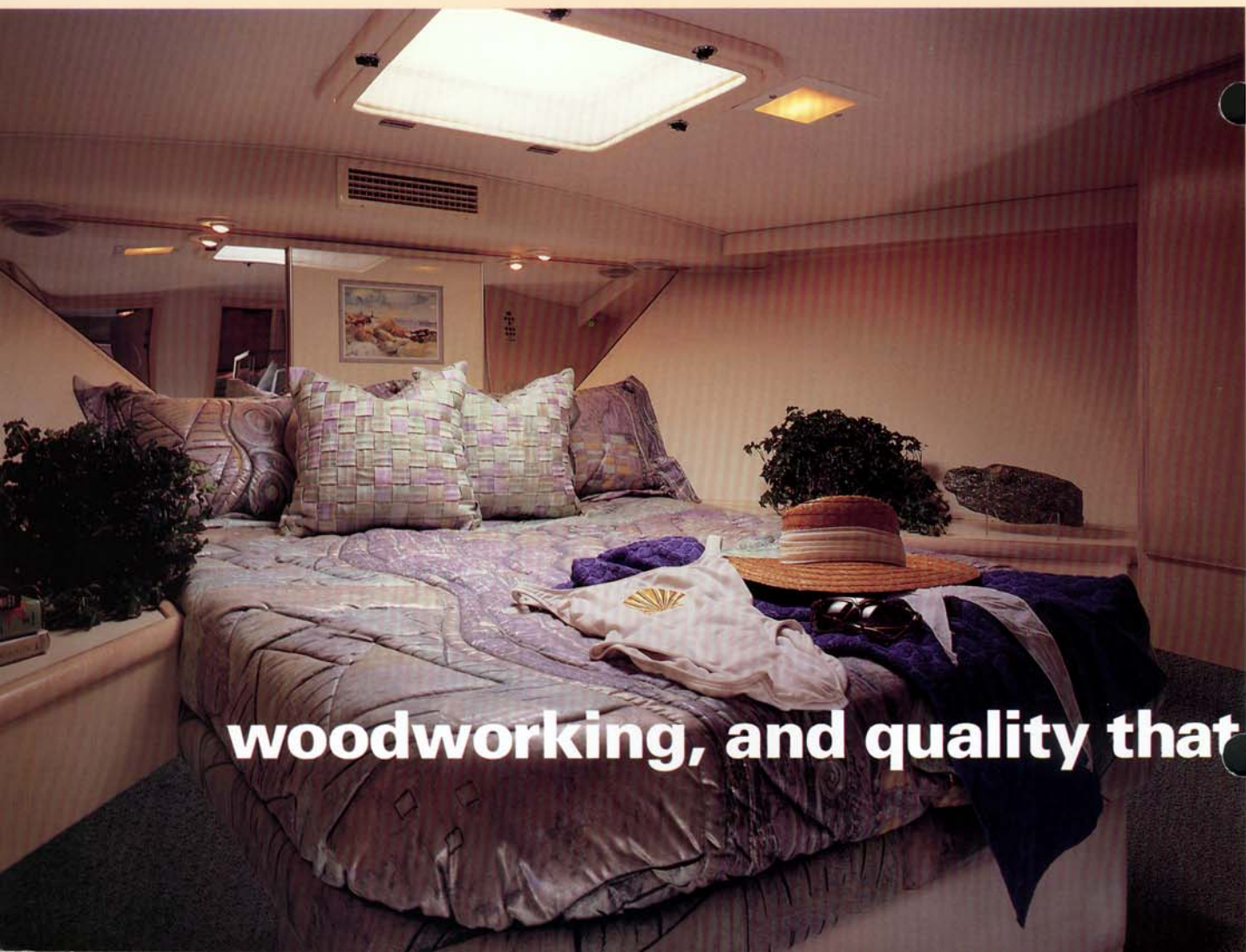

Whether you're offshore for a week of determined fishing or just running away from home for the

weekend, your Hatteras 43 Convertible awaits you with the kind of luxury we'd all like to become accustomed to.

The master stateroom makes a masterful statement. Run your hand along the soft surfaces and feel the patina of the fine wood cabinetry. Let your eye measure all the storage space, only to discover even more. Stretch out across the queen bed, knowing there's enough walk-around space when you're ready to move about. Look around; here's everything you'd hope for to make a lengthy cruise leisurely.

From the master stateroom, there's private access to the head, which can also be accessed through the companionway for use as a day head.

One sign of a true tournament fishing machine is engine room access from the cockpit. The standard engines are D.D. 6V-92TA rated at 535 SHP each. Also standard: an 8Kw generator with sound shield, and an electric hot water heater. Special alcoves in the engine room house the generator and other equipment to give you more room to move about.
