Upon first glance, the Hatteras 46 Convertible stops you in your tracks. Its sleek, contemporary design is compelling, arresting, unforgettable, pure Hatteras.

This Hatteras is immediately appealing. And almost before you know how, you know why. The boat is beautiful. The 46 Convertible has the look of a winner, and the feel of a champion.

Before you read much further, allow us a cautionary note. The 46C may stir a passion in you, a fire we've found among Hatteras owners everywhere. As has happened many times before, this boat may steal your heart away.

On its practical side, the 46C is a large and accommodating yacht with a choice of two interior layouts. It's a capable fisherman and an exhilarating cruiser. The boat's solid, stable, and big on conveniences.

From the flybridge, it's responsive and designed to place you in complete control. The console design is modern, and accepts all of your electronics without need of an

overhead bin. And of course, topside seating is comfortable and plenty.

Aft, that same feeling of control is given over to those with a passion for fishing or a love of the water. The sizable, 121-square-foot cockpit is fully outfitted with a molded-in bait and tackle center, removable fish-box in the sole, twin removable storage tubs, fresh water washdown, and more.

The cockpit section contains another Hatteras innovation: a handy access to the engine room, where twin Detroit Diesel 8V-92TAs (720 SHP), or optional MAN D2840 LE401 (780 SHP) diesels provide all the power you'll ever need.

There are a lot of good reasons for this boat's appeal. Handsome style and functional design are but two. And the further you look, the more you find.

Slip into something comfortable.

In the salon looking forward shown here in the main picture, you quickly see the emphasis throughout the dinette version of the Hatteras 46C is on quality and style. Notice how the galley remains a part of the main living area aboard, expanding your social domain. And, by including the dinette, which is forward of the crafted-in entertainment center to starboard, you gain yet another gathering spot, perfect for serious strategy sessions or relaxed conversations.

If you choose the dual head version, shown at lower left, the design accommodates your passion for privacy without sacrificing the pleasures of sociability. The salon is a large and welcome space, colorful and comfortable. As in the other layout, the galley is open to and very much a part of the salon.

The space devoted to the dinette, shown in the center vignette, is more than sufficient to satisfy several hungry sportsmen with ease. It's adjacent to the galley, and has almost 80 cubic feet of storage area below the sole — room enough for anything from galley stores to extra gear. And the table lowers to create additional sleeping accommodations, to accommodate an unexpected guest.

The mid-level galley, illustrated at the lower right, offers all the features you'd expect aboard a Hatteras. Quality and convenience. Style and efficiency. This kitchen is fully-equipped to facilitate your culinary creations, whether it's a complete gourmet dinner or a sophisticated snack.





Once inside, the quality and craftsmanship built into the 46 Convertible will be quickly apparent to you. Here is a lot more luxury than you might ever expect to have in a 46-foot boat, but every bit as much as you'd expect to have aboard a Hatteras.

For example, its choice of two layouts opens your options for living. With one preference, a dual head version, you can create the perfect feeling of privacy on board. With the other, a dinette arrangement, you've dramatically highlighted your social side.

With either option, you'll feel right at home in the salon. There are 112 square feet of elegance here, with a decor package that includes an L-shaped lounge, coffee table, and a complete, crafted-in entertainment center with 20" television, AM/FM stereo, and cassette deck.

And both layouts include a well-equipped and spacious galley that's open to the salon, keeping everyone in the conversation. Abundant counter space, a two-burner cooktop, a microwave/convection oven, and an 11-cubic-foot refrigerator/freezer with icemaker are standard equipment.

Its quality, craftsmanship, and optional living arrangements redefine what you thought was possible in a boat in this class. Not surprisingly, the appeal of the 46C is undeniable, even before you've been below.



The dual head layout provides superb accommodations for two couples or more. Both staterooms have the use of separate heads, one of which is private to the master stateroom.

The start of something big.

The master stateroom looking forward, as illustrated in the central photograph, is the same in quality and size, regardless of which version of the 46 Convertible you select. Walk-around space, even with its sumptuous queen berth and twin port and starboard lockers, is plentiful in this domain. And, to add an even greater feeling of spaciousness, a mirrored bulkhead at the bow adds a light and airy aspect all around.

Aboard the dinette version of the 46C, the guest stateroom quarters, shown here at the lower left, lie just forward of the dinette. Designed and decorated to please your most important guests, this stateroom provides twin full-length over-and-under berths, a full-height hanging locker, and abundant drawer space. Access to the head in this layout is directly across the companionway.

In either layout, the master head, shown in the center vignette, is large and well-appointed. Its facilities include a stall shower, a lighted vanity and mirror, and more. In the dual head version, this space becomes a dedicated part of the master suite, with a private access to the head from inside the master stateroom.

The guest stateroom in the dual head version, shown at the bottom far right, moves aft without losing deck space to accommodate the inclusion of the additional head. The second head is every bit as luxurious as the master head, and includes an access from the guest quarters, as well as access from the companionway.





Take a couple of steps into the companionway and you'll discover yet another appealing facet of this boat. The staterooms aboard the 46C are exceptional.

The forward master stateroom is its own realm, featuring a queen-size tapered berth with plenty of walk-around room on both sides. And a mirrored bulkhead at the head of the berth brings a bright and open look to this domain.

If you select the dual head layout, the master stateroom transforms into a master suite, with a private full-size head with stall shower. In both options, hanging locker and drawer space is plentiful.

The stateroom amidships provides guest quarters with a host of features. Its sizable space accommodates full-length over-and-under berths, generous drawer and locker space, and direct access to the adjoining day head on the two-head version.

In spaciousness and style, in quality and options, in its appealing and functional design, the Hatteras 46 Convertible is a beautiful boat to possess. Once you see it for yourself, you'll discover this simple fact very, very quickly.
