Ever since you placed that carefully-chosen name across the transom of your first boat not many years ago, this — the Hatteras 52 Motor Yacht or 52 Cockpit Motor Yacht — is the kind of yacht you knew you'd someday own.

It's the accommodations that come with this size which capture your imagination, the amenities that include three honest-to-goodness staterooms, an aft deck large enough for the party of the year, and the abundance of roominess everywhere else.

In many ways, the Hatteras 52 Motor Yacht and 52 Cockpit Motor Yacht are the ideal size. They provide the perfect balance for your desire to have the most living space at your disposal



without losing your hands-on approach to boating.

The flybridge, for example, is a large and accommodating deck for family and friends, yet command remains firmly with the pilot at the complete, well-planned wrap-around control console forward. Encircling this command center, an L-shaped bench to port and side bench to starboard complete the seating arrangements for up to eight guests.

Take note that the wrap-around windshield and aft-raking radar arch are not only functional, but complement the dramatic low-profile lines of the contemporary superstructure and proven Hatteras modified-vee hull.

Yet while its exterior styling suggests a sleek cruiser, the vast interior layouts and accommodations aboard are ready reminders the 52 MY and 52 CMY are exceptionally comfortable as live-aboard yachts.

This is especially true if you opt to enclose the aft deck and create an additional living area. The aft deck

is veranda-sized as it is and, with the optional inclusion of windows and heating/air conditioning, you can enjoy a second salon aboard.



The aft deck brings a cabana feel to the Motor Yacht.

The main salon is equally spacious and even more luxurious, just as you'd expect aboard any motor yacht carrying the "Hatteras" insignia. The custom U-shaped sofa and coffee table to port are substantial but do not crowd the room. There is still plenty of space left for walk-around room, a plush, upholstered chair, and the complete entertainment center.

The staterooms aboard both yachts are comfortable hideaways, where you and your guests can wrap yourselves in elegance. The master and bow guest staterooms accommodate bountiful queen-size berths and custom drawers, as well as fully private heads with showers (which feature a tub in the master stateroom). As you would have it, the third aft guest stateroom is also very comfortable and large enough to include hanging locker and storage space with its upper and lower berths.

Everywhere you look aboard these Hatteras motor yachts, with their luxurious accommodations, their powerful elegance and style, and their grand proportions overall, you will quickly discover with delight the scope of your achievement.

This is the Hatteras motor yacht you've always wanted, a truly splendid and genuine yacht in every sense.
