
The Hatteras 50 Convertible is one screamer of a sportfishing convertible! With a glass-smooth ride, the smallest in our fleet offers power options able to attain speeds approaching 40 knots. The same raked lines and curved edges that popularized her sisterships have been inherited by the 50.

The standard arrangement on the 50 offers an incredibly spacious three-stateroom, two-head arrangement. Both master and bow staterooms boast queen walk-around berths with storage below. The full galley features standard undercounter drawer-style refrigerator and freezer, four-burner cooktop and microwave/convection oven. For those who prefer a more expansive salon, the optional mid-level galley provides additional space for entertaining in the salon. In either arrangement, the salon showcases standard fluted wood valances with blinds, L-shaped lounge seating with rod storage, coffee table and icemaker.

On the flying bridge you'll find a pod-style tournament console with recessed electronics box, top-loading insulated drink box and rod storage. If you prefer to catch the fishing action from the bridge, you'll enjoy the extended flying bridge overhang delivering expanded walking room while also providing a haven from the sun for those in the cockpit.

The 135 square-foot cockpit area includes both seawater and freshwater wash downs, bait and tackle center, drop-in bait freezer, rod holders and a large fish box with macerator pump.

Quick and agile, smooth and luxurious, the new Hatteras 50 Convertible is devoted to the serious sportfisherman.







The sky around Walker's Cay at sunset makes you wonder why people ever want to leave here.

The 50 Salon and Galley




The 50 Bow Stateroom






