If the time has come when you decide you deserve to really live, you simply couldn't do any better. Because aboard these, livability is everything. And truly something.

With a fiberglass hull designed for us by naval architect Jack Hargrave, these yachts reflect the best of both worlds. First your practical world, with the room that meets your needs with a grand sense of place and purpose. Then your sea-going world, acknowledging your rightful place in command of a commanding Hatteras.

Above and below, the watchword is *space*. Clean, majestic, refreshing space that comes from an 18'2" beam and a remarkable execution that gives you more than you would expect — even if you're already a Hatteras owner.

The emphasis on livability begins with the deckhouse. The full-width salon offers you (hold your breath now) over 275 square feet of living space. It offers a built-in entertainment center, featuring a wet bar with ice maker, AM/FM stereo cassette player, plus room for your TV and VCR. But the big thing is the room itself: the freedom of choice in how to use it; how to arrange your furniture, including (if you wish) an area for formal dining; how to make your own personal statement. And the space to do it all, magnificently.

Once you've adjusted to the spaciousness, the next thing to take in is the bright, fresh look of Hatteras elegance. Contemporary styling refinements include new natural wood accents on the cabinetry, rounded wood corners on bulkheads, and lighter, quietly comforting wall and counter coverings . . . in a salon with so much window area, such excellent climate control, you'll feel you're in the living room of a penthouse. And, in a way, you are.



DINETTE:

The U-Shaped Dinette, on the deckhouse level, with upholstered seats and storage under: it seats five hungry (and very fortunate) people who clearly have an appetite for good living.

GALLEY:

The Galley is, well, huge. The look is light and bright, the space is surprising, and the efficiency is remarkable. Fully equipped with refrigerator/freezer, range with eye-level oven, dishwasher, and disposal.

SALON:

The Salon is everything you'd want in a home — assuming you'd want everything. Here's the room you want to surround yourself in the luxury of quiet, contemporary styling and the comfort of Hatteras craftsmanship. It includes a complete entertainment center, with wet bar, as well as plenty of space for a formal dining area.

PILOT HOUSE:

The Pilot House is fully enclosed with a complete control console and completely Hatteras-quality cabinetry for your electronics.



MASTER STATEROOM:

The Master Stateroom is Hatteras thoughtfulness at its most livable. Maybe we should really call it the Master State-suite. Here, in the bedroom area, you'll wake up to the fine craftsmanship, the matched woods, and the contemporary touches you've come to expect . . . from Hatteras. King-size berth, built-in nightstands, his-and-her dressers, wardrobes, the works!

MASTER HEAD:

The Master Head has a full-size tub with shower (of course) comforting styling, and one more thing you might have been missing: lots of storage.





Now you're ready for the galley. The fresh, cheery look continues through dinner, with the tasteful touch of contemporary almond laminate. The galley is fully equipped with a side-by-side refrigerator/freezer with ice maker, four-burner range with eye-level oven, dishwasher, garbage disposal, and room for a built-in microwave. You won't have to point out to your spouse that there's plenty of cabinet space *and* plenty of room to move about. Believe us, it will be noticed!

To starboard, of course, is the U-shaped dinette with upholstered seats and storage under. Here five hungry people can relax and enjoy what few others can: the sea-going life, Hatteras style.

Before you're tempted to go below, a word or two about the pilot house. It's fully enclosed and includes a complete control console forward, and built-in overhead cabinetry (*Hatteras* cabinetry) designed for the installation of electronics. With a comfortable riding lounge with chart storage. We never forget what a yacht is all about.

Below, everything is as far above the norm as you can get.

The experience continues. The feeling of stateliness grows on you.

From the moment you enter the master stateroom, you'll never want to leave. Because the first thing you'll discover is that it's not a room . . . it's a suite. A large, impressive master suite. Now what we mean by a real second home really sinks in. The master stateroom abounds in *Hatteras* quality. Beautifully finished woods, fitted as only *Hatteras* craftsmen seem to be able to do it. A king-size berth with built-in nightstands (you're going to live here, not simply stay here). His-and-her dressers and wardrobes, a master head with full-size tub with shower, and a separate master 52-square-foot dressing area!

You'll love this "dedicated" space you've never had before . . . the lighted vanity . . . the extra drawers . . . the cedar-lined wardrobe with mirrored doors. (Did your condo have all this? Well, why should your *Hatteras* be any different?)

Executive bulletin: this area can also be used as your corporate headquarters at sea. It can easily be adapted for use as a private ocean-going office.

The next-best thing to owning it is being a guest.

The master suite may be something, but it's still not everything.

The *Hatteras* 63 Motor Yacht or 68 Cockpit Motor Yacht is your four-bedroom, four-bathroom home.

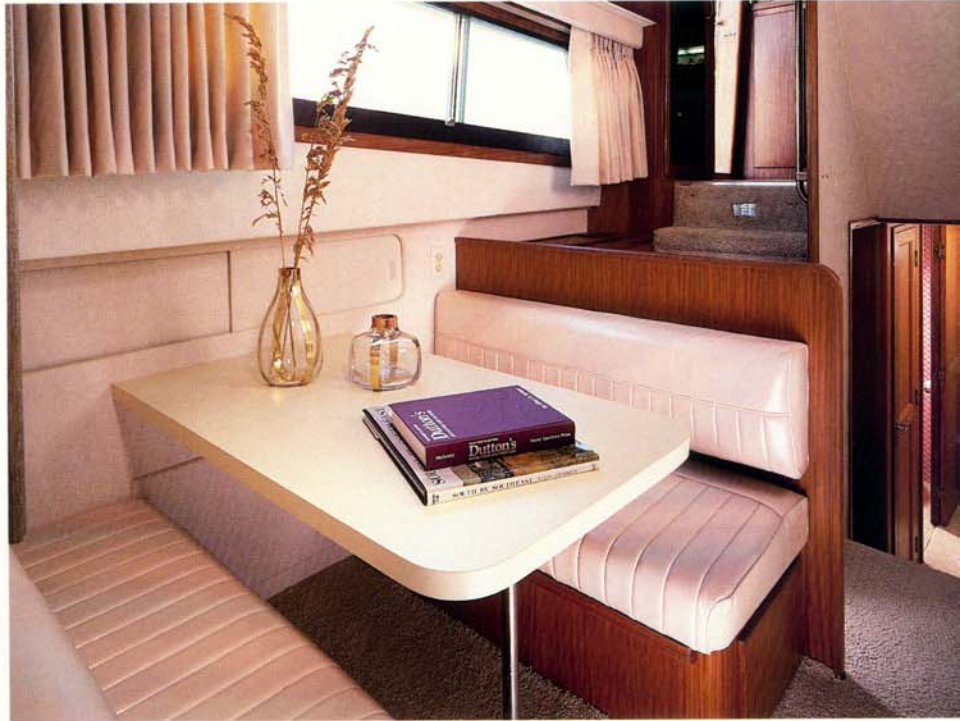
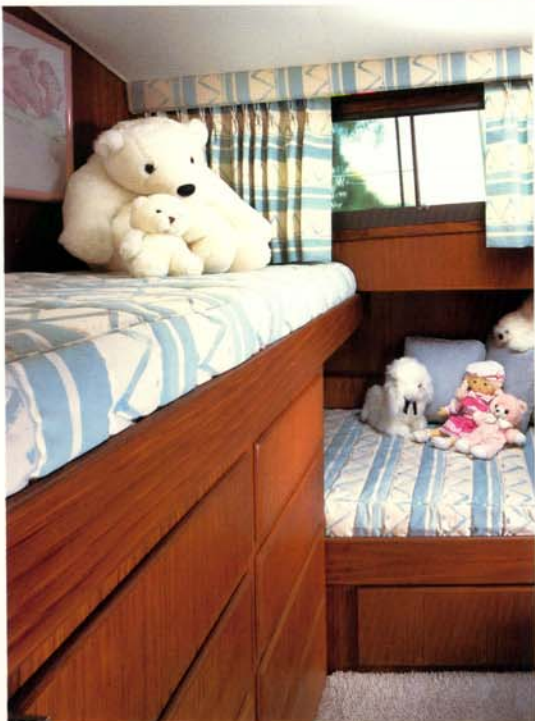
The aft guest stateroom features twin berths with drawers under, plus nightstand, hanging locker, and overhead blanket locker. Conveniently accessible is a private head with stall shower.



DRESSING AREA:

Are you ready for this? Certainly. A separate 52-square foot dressing area. We call it "dedicated" space, and we dedicated ourselves to giving you your own special room (and lots of it) in this most-stately stateroom.

The mirrored doors in the Dressing Area open to a cedar-lined wardrobe.



The companionway also features linen storage plus a hanging locker, sized for a washer/dryer.

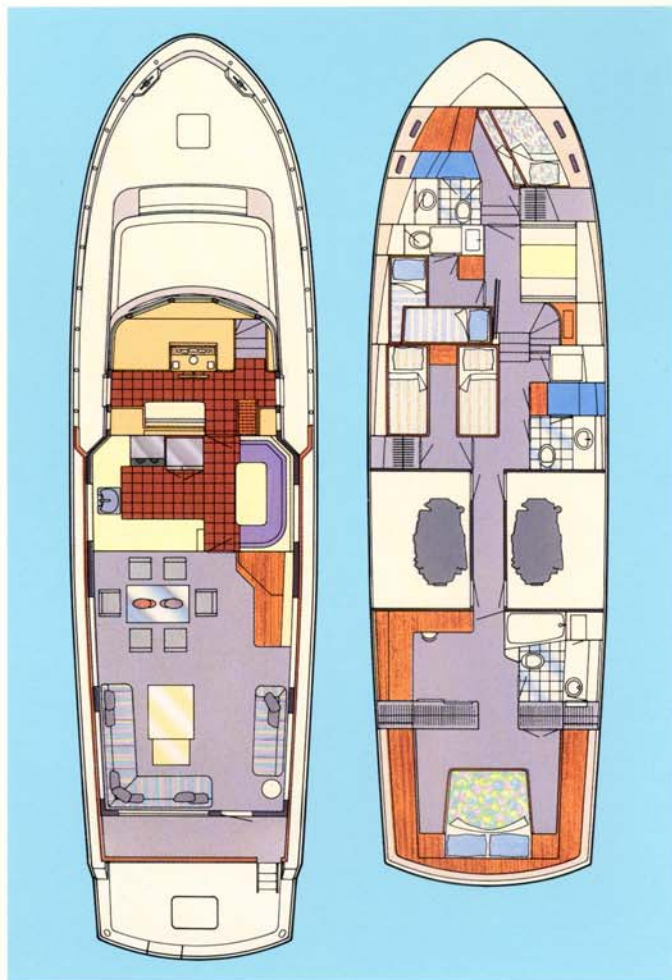
The forward guest stateroom offers over-and-under berths, drawer storage, and hanging locker. An adjoining head is complete with shower.

And the private bow stateroom includes upper and lower berths, a dresser with drawers and a hanging locker, and its own head with stall shower. Another welcome surprise is a lower deck dinette, to give your crew extra privacy (or as alternatives, a place for the kids to play, an extra desk space or utility area).

With all this luxury, it's still all Hatteras.

Let's go back to the beginning, for a moment, and point out the most important single feature of all. This isn't just any magnificent yacht you're enjoying. It's a Hatteras. With the Hatteras electrical and mechanical systems, the envy of the marine industry. The famous Hatteras Systems Monitor. The Hatteras breed of power and performance, with twin G.M. 12V-71TI diesels. Quiet, efficient air conditioning. And everywhere, the Hatteras insistence on quality, even where compromise goes unnoticed, where others may choose to cut corners.

AFT GUEST STATEROOM:

The Aft Guest Stateroom features twin berths and plenty of storage in a setting that compares with some master staterooms. In fact, if you enjoy impressive surroundings and a private head, and don't become a Hatteras 63 MY or 68 CMY owner, do the next best thing: be an invited guest!

BOW STATEROOM:

The Bow Stateroom (right, and number four if you're counting) respects your crew's privacy perfectly . . . with a head complete with shower (also number four) adjoining.



THE 68 COCKPIT:

For sunning and relaxing, for some fishing or simply for stern boarding, the convenient cockpit with wide transom gate gives your motor yacht an added dimension — you'll know you have everything — and then some!

FORWARD GUEST STATEROOM:

The Forward Guest Stateroom (left) gives you everything to make family or friends feel at home. Over-and-under berths, drawers, hanging locker, and yes, an adjoining head with shower.

LOWER DINETTE:

The Lower Deck Dinette (center) may be a surprising "bonus" at first, but when you think of your crew's needs — or your kid's need for a play area, or your own need for an extra desk — you'll be surprised how valuable it is.
